FEDERAL UPDATE

INFRASTRUCTURE & SURFACE TRANSP REAUTH

- ✓ Senate bill increases federal transit formula funds by 30%
- ✓ MARTA Priority: Small Starts Program - INCLUDED
 - ✓ Eligibility increased to \$400M
 - ✓ Federal share increased to \$150M
- ✓ Numerous new grant programs administered by Secretary Buttigieg

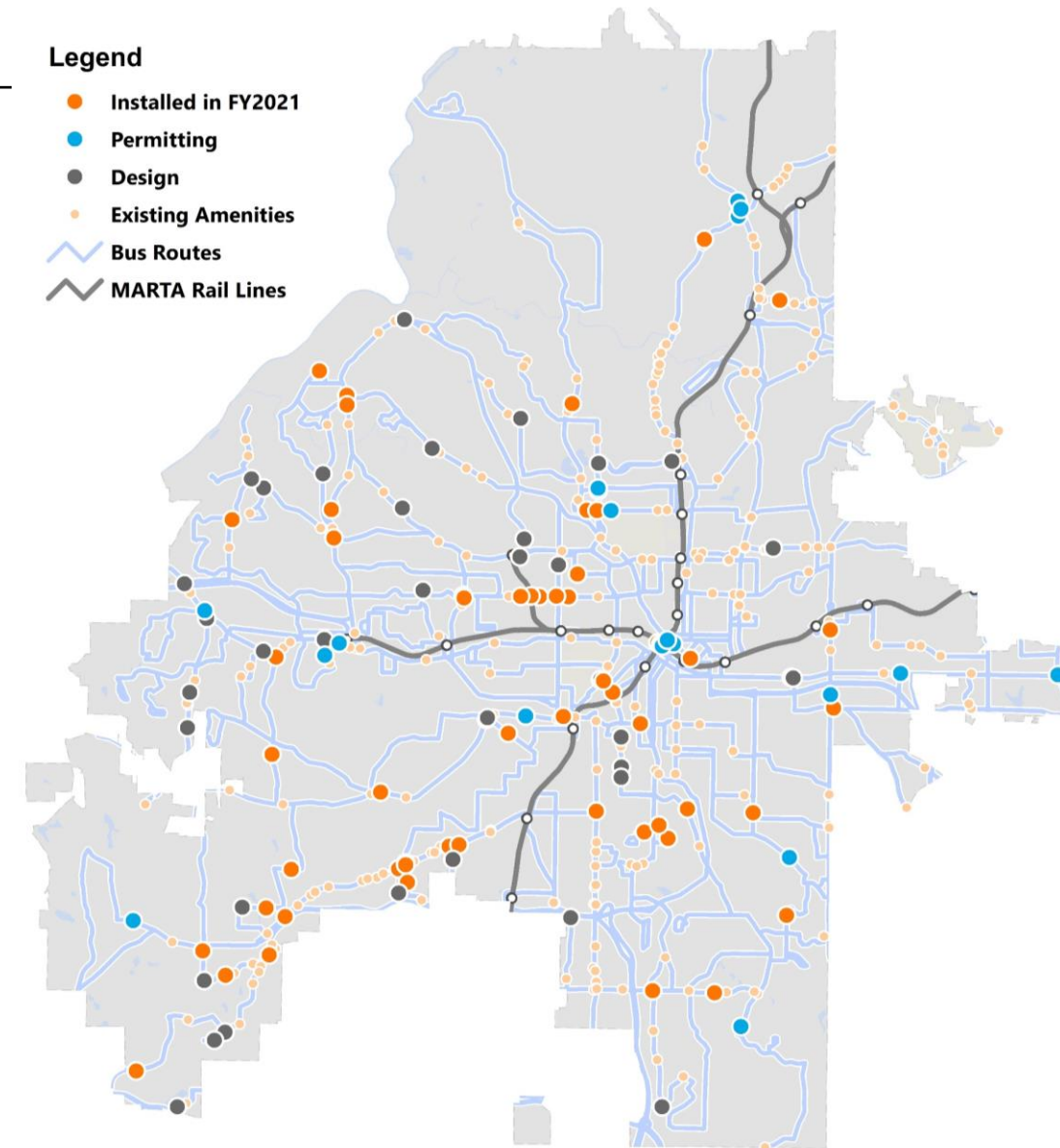

BUS SHELTERS UPDATE

- ✓ City of Atlanta will receive 50 additional shelters in FY22
- ✓ 58 shelters have been installed so far
- ✓ We also have 18 in permitting and 38 under design
- ✓ By the end of FY22 City of Atlanta will have received at least 114 new bus shelters

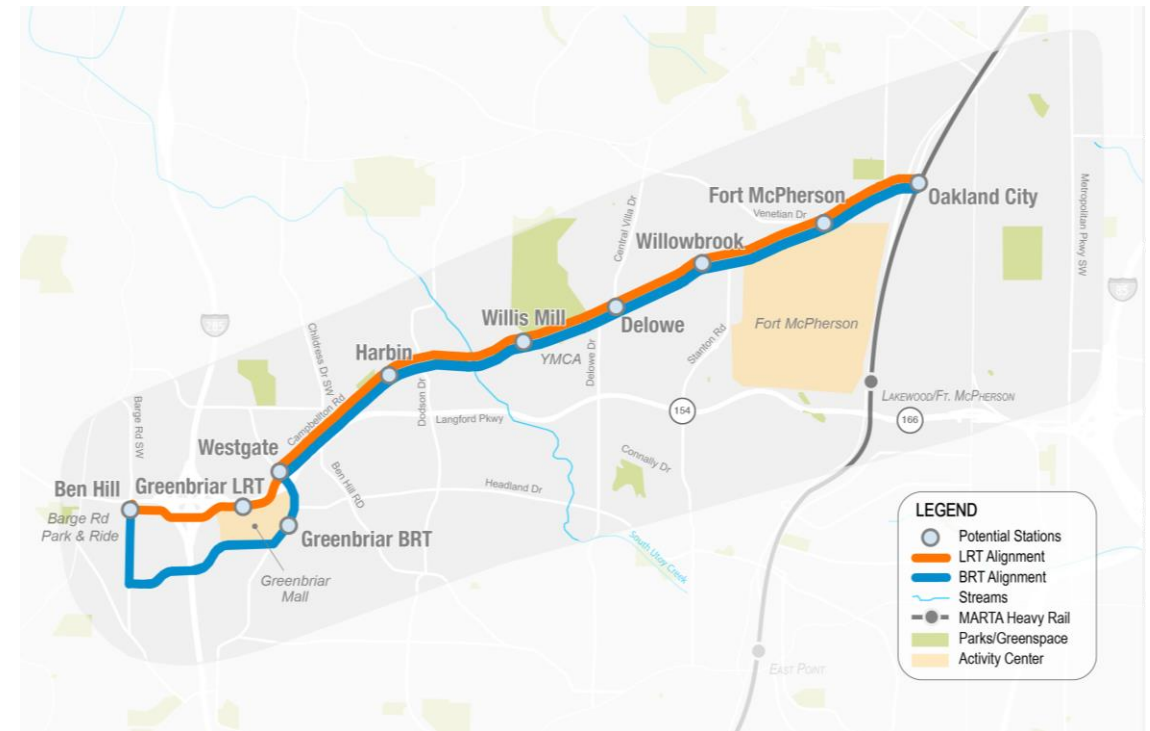
SUMMERHILL BUS RAPID TRANSIT

- ✓ 16 Transit Stops
 - ✓ 14" level boarding platforms
 - ✓ State-of-the-art passenger amenities
 - ✓ Off-board fare collection
 - ✓ Security cameras
 - ✓ Accessible, safe, and secure
- ✓ 28 Signalized Intersections
 - ✓ ADA-accessible pedestrian accommodations
 - ✓ Transit Signal Priority (TSP)



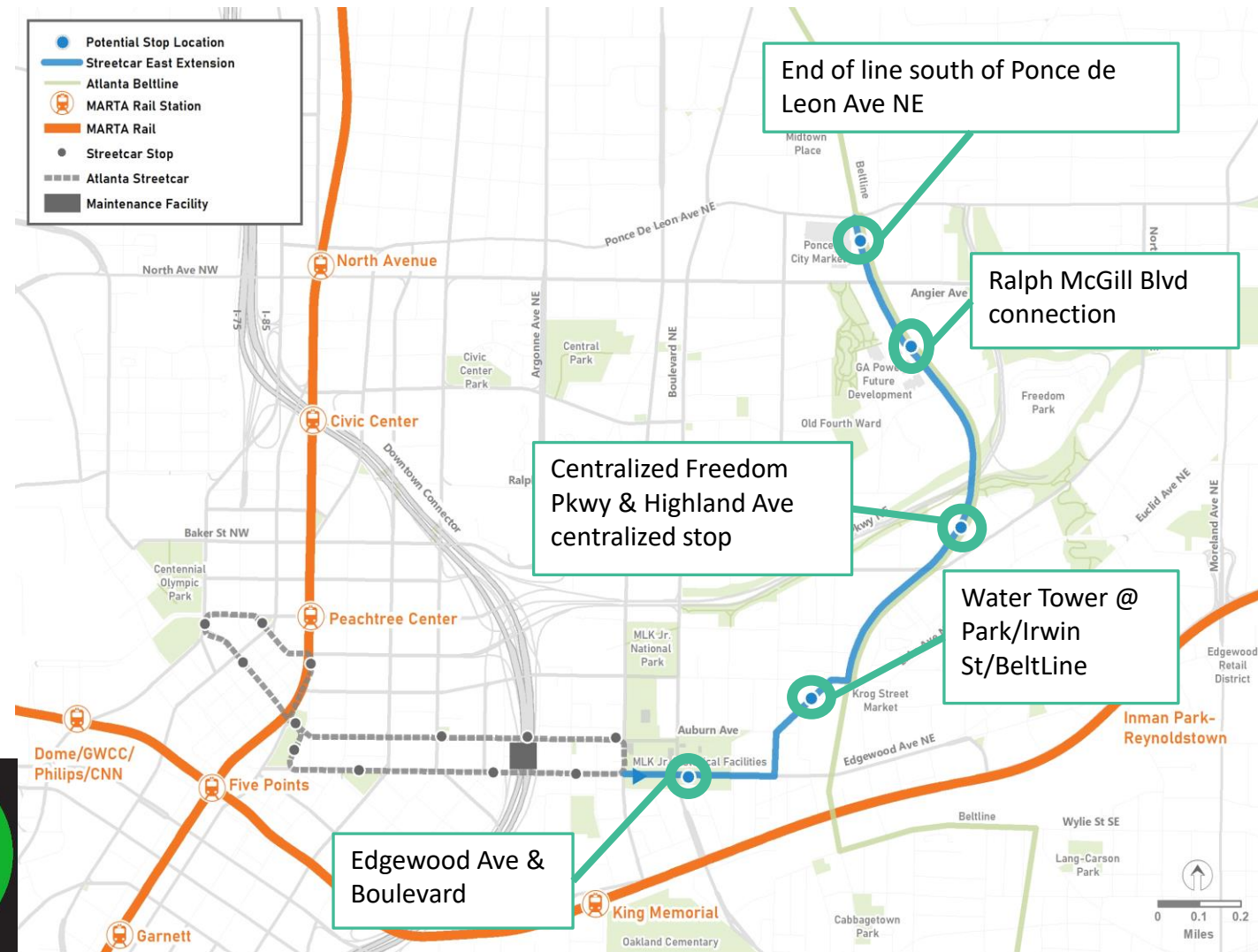
CAMPBELLTON CORRIDOR

- ✓ MARTA is advancing planning and design of a high-capacity transit investment along the Campbellton Rd corridor
- ✓ Recent public outreach activities:
 - ✓ Virtual public meeting
 - ✓ June 10
 - ✓ 116 attendees
 - ✓ Virtual meeting room
 - ✓ 1,945 unique visitors
 - ✓ Corridor canvassing
 - ✓ Residential and commercial property owners
 - ✓ On-board buses, rail stations & direct mailers
 - ✓ Project survey distribution
 - ✓ 700+ paper and online survey completed
 - ✓ Pop-up open houses/community meetings
 - ✓ July 21, 27, 28 & 31; August 21
 - ✓ 70 attendees



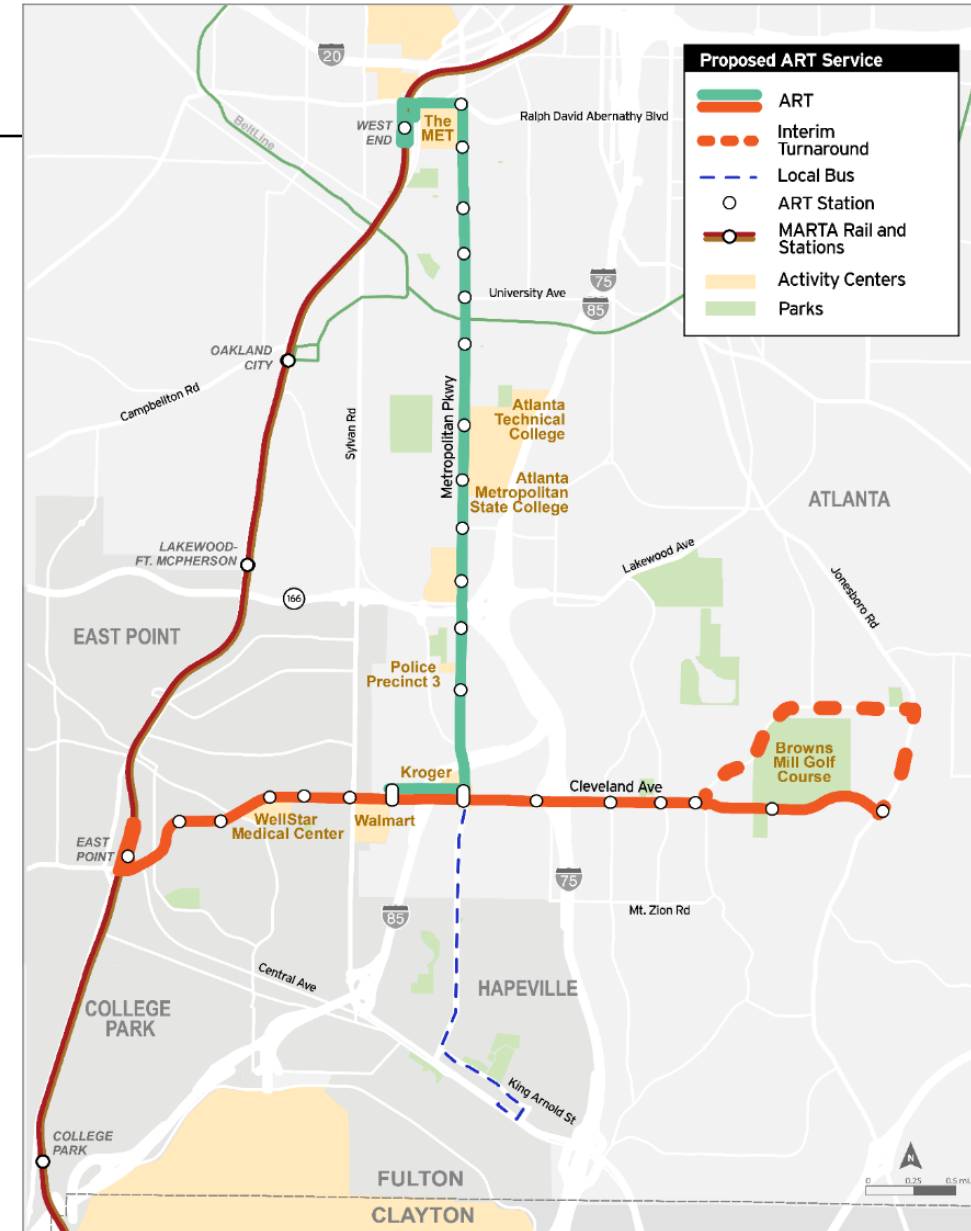
STREETCAR EAST EXTENSION/BELTLINE RAIL

- ✓ **Expedited Streetcar East Extension planning phase** by using local funding only
 - ✓ Future phases may seek federal funding
- ✓ **Travel modelling** to be performed
- ✓ **Visual simulations** to be prepared
- ✓ Early public engagement results included concerns around **design impacts of transit**
- ✓ **Public engagement** to continue



CLEVELAND/METROPOLITAN ART

- ✓ Implement Arterial Rapid Transit (ART) service along Cleveland Ave and Metropolitan Pkwy by 2024
- ✓ Completion of 30% design plans and transition into final design
- ✓ On-going coordination with partners, stakeholders and public
